A Covid-19 reminder...

Children should not come into school if they have symptoms of Covid-19 or have had a positive [PCR test](#) result.

When to self-isolate

Self-isolate straight away and get a PCR test as soon as possible if you have any of these 3 symptoms of COVID-19, even if they are mild:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

You should also self-isolate straight away if:

- you've tested positive for COVID-19
- someone you live with has symptoms or tested positive
(* unless you are not required to self-isolate)
- you've been told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace.

*Individuals not required to self-isolate are if any of the following apply:

- they are fully vaccinated
- they are below the age of 18 years and 6 months
- they have taken part in or are currently part of an approved COVID-19 vaccine trial
- they are not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons

DATES FOR YOUR DIARY

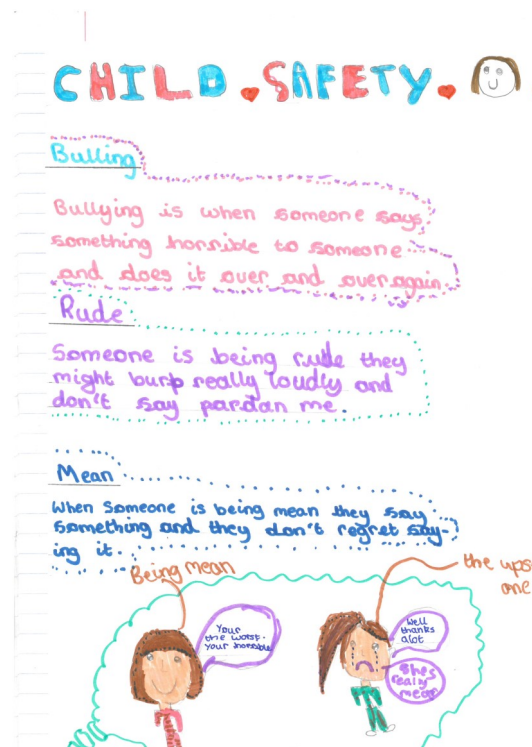
We have set a number of dates for this academic year for class assemblies and productions. These will be reviewed nearer the time and are subject to change following guidance.

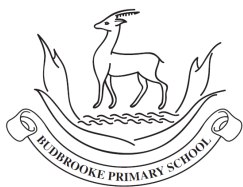

Last week in PSHE lessons we focussed on anti bullying. The children discussed the difference between being rude, mean and being a bully.





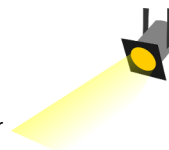
CLASS SPOTLIGHT— PINE

DROP OFF AND COLLECTION

Please remember that without prior permission parents are not allowed to drive onto the school grounds to park for drop off or collection.

This is a health and safety issue with many children and parents moving around the site.

This applies to our office entrance and our staff car park located near the kids club entrance.

Please note that children are not allowed to ride on their bikes or scooters whilst on the school site. This is to prevent any injuries to the rider or any pedestrians during one of the busiest times of the school day.

SCHOOL UNIFORM
