# Chair

- Provide leadership for the PTA
- Lead on liaison with the School Management Team regarding PTA events
- · Manage Committee meetings
- Welcome and involve new members
- Sign the approved minutes of the last meeting
- Get to know the members of the Committee
- Write the annual report in co-operation with the Secretary.
- Sign cheques for the PTA with one other committee member.
- Lead on Summer and Winter Fetes

## Vice-Chair

• Support the Chair and take on Chair's role when required.

# Secretary

- Deal with correspondence
- Prepare agendas
- · Call meetings, giving plenty of notice
- Keep a record of attendance at meetings
- Take notes during meetings
- Write up the minutes of the meetings
- Distribute the minutes to all the committee
- Make meeting and event arrangements
- Co-sign cheques as required
- Write the Annual Report with the Chair and Treasurer.

### **Treasurer**

- Maintaining accurate and auditable financial records
- Managing all income and expenditure
- Reporting on income and expenditure at meetings
- Liaising with the bank and managing the list of authorised signatories
- Preparing and co-signing cheques
- Completing and submitting the charity's Annual Report to the Charity Commission
- Completing returns for small lottery events
- · Managing the Amazon Smile account
- · Liaising with HMRC when required
- Preparing all event floats
- Advising on profits, costs, purchase quantities, and any other information as required
